Players Code of Conduct

Purpose

The Midwest FC goal as a club is to provide each player an opportunity to advance their skills as a soccer player, become team players, and learn good sportsmanship in a competitive soccer environment. This can only be achieved through a partnership with trainers, parents and players. Everyone must work together to achieve this common goal.

To achieve this goal we are asking players to read, understand and agree to the following Code of Conduct. Please sign the code and return the form with your registration packet.

1. I will play soccer because I enjoy the game and want to become a better player. I choose to play soccer for me and not for my parents.
2. I will come to practice in appropriate attire (club practice jersey).
3. I will come to practice with a positive attitude prepared and ready to learn.
4. I will come to every game prepared and ready to play - this includes being well nourished and well rested.
5. I will respect my trainer at all times.
6. I will respect my teammates at all times.
7. I will be humble when I win and gracious when I lose.
8. I will not use profanity during games and practices.
9. I will work for the good of my team and give my best effort at all times
10. I will show respect for the authority of the referee. I understand that referees are human and may make mistakes at times.
11. I will not discuss my opinion of the calls the referee makes during the game. I will rely on my trainer to voice any dissent or dissatisfaction with the referee after the game.
12. I will show good sportsmanship before, during and after games.
13. I will control my temper and not retaliate even if I believe I have been wronged.
14. If I receive a red card, I will sit out the following game.
15. I am also responsible to pay any and all fines, as determined by the league in which I play, if I receive a red card.
16. I understand that the Midwest FC reserve the right to review any violations of these rules. Violations may result in suspension or an appropriate response.
